

Report on NSS Selection Camp 2025–27

Organized by NSS Unit No.210, Najath College of Science and Technology, Karuvarakundu.

Dates: 13th & 14th October 2025 (Monday & Tuesday)

Venue: College Campus and Seminar Hall, Najath College of Science and Technology, Karuvarakundu

Introduction:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit No. 210 of Najath College of Science and Technology, Karuvarakundu, conducted a **Selection Camp** for first-year students on **13th and 14th October 2025**. The primary objective of the camp was to select dedicated and service-minded volunteers for the **2025–27 NSS batch**. The camp activities were designed to evaluate students' interest, commitment, and aptitude for community service and leadership.

Day 1: 13th October 2025 (Monday):

Time: 9.30 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.

Venue: College Campus

The first day of the camp began with grouping the registered students into 10 groups, each comprising 10 members and led by a group leader. The teams were assigned the task of campus cleaning and plastic waste collection. The activity aimed to promote cleanliness, environmental responsibility, and teamwork among the participants.

Time: 2.00 p.m. – 3.00 p.m.

Venue: Seminar Hall

In the afternoon session, an orientation class was conducted on the topic "*National Service Scheme – Its History and Objectives*." The session was led by Mr. Haneefa M. K., Programme Officer, NSS Unit No.210, who gave an insightful talk on the vision, mission, and importance of NSS in developing the personality of students through community service.

Day 2: 14th October 2025 (Tuesday):

Time: 11.00 a.m. – 12.15 p.m.

Venue: Seminar Hall

The second day began with a written test based on the NSS syllabus, carrying 10 marks. This was followed by an interview session to assess the students' motivation and awareness about social service.

Later, creative competitions were conducted to identify students with artistic and technical skills:

- Poster Making Competition on the topic "*NSS Enrolment*."
- Video Editing Competition on the topic "*College Campus*."

These activities provided students an opportunity to express their creativity and showcase their understanding of the NSS spirit.

Participation and Selection:

A total of 108 students registered for the camp. After careful evaluation, 60 students were selected as NSS volunteers for the 2025–27 batch including 10 are in the waitlist.

Selection Criteria:

- Campus Cleaning – 10 Marks
 - Written Test – 15 Marks
 - Interview – 10 Marks
 - Poster & Video Editing – 15 Marks
- (Total: 50 Marks)

The selection was made purely on a merit and rank basis, ensuring fairness and transparency in the process.
