

Report on Two-Day Nature Study Camp

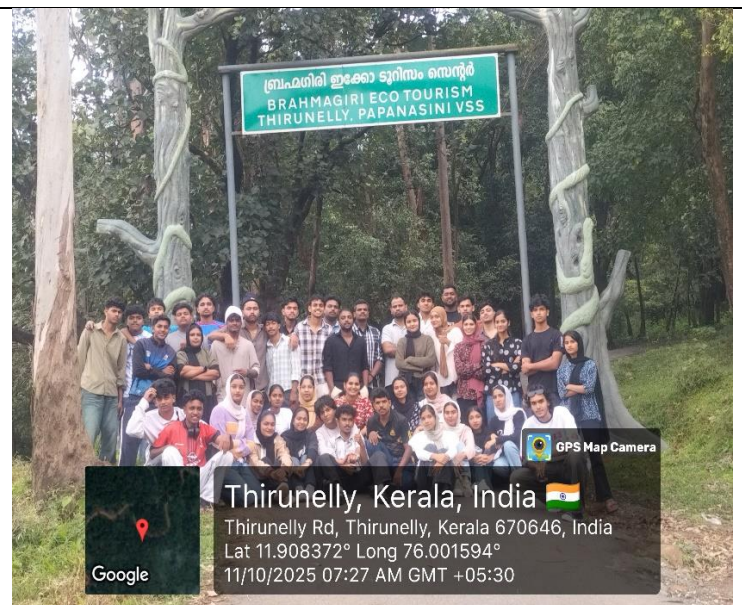


Day 2 – 11/10/2025 (Saturday):
